



Atwood RV Gas Detector – Model 36720

Using propane-fueled appliances in your RV can increase the risk of fire or explosion. Protect your family with a detector that gives early alerts and is less sensitive to false alarms. Easy to operate and uses less power than other detectors.

- Propane gas detector alerts you to potentially dangerous levels of gas in your RV
 - Detects levels as low as 2,000 ppm
- Fuel-cell sensor is less sensitive to false alarm triggers than other detectors
- Test/mute button lets you test and silence alarm
- Indicator lights take out the guesswork
 - Green light blinks periodically during normal operation
 - Red light flashes while active alarm is sounding
 - Red light blinks periodically if power is low
 - Yellow light blinks if maintenance is needed
- Power conservation mode reserves current draw if your RV power surges or dips
- Adapter plate included for flush-mount installation
- White color
- ETL-tested for residential and RV use

 - Power conservation mode: 10 mA

- Alarm intensity: 85 decibels at a distance of 10'

- **Note:** Because LP gas is heavier than air, this detector should be installed no more than 18" from the floor so that it can accurately detect the amount of gas in your RV.

Propane (LP gas) is usually the first choice of power in RVs, but a leak could result in dangerous levels of explosive gas in your motor home. This detector gives you peace of mind by alerting you if there is as little as 2,000 ppm of LP gas present. The lowest possible explosive level of propane gas is 20,000 ppm, which is 10 times the amount this unit detects, so your

family will still have plenty of time to get to safety if the alarm sounds
